2. Application & Fee

- Once both the application and fee are submitted, your child's name will be added to the appropriate school year's waitlist.

3. Waiting list

- Students applying for our pre-primary or primary programs will be immediately added to our first-come, first-serve waitlist for their age and for the appropriate school year they are applying for. You will be notified if/once a space is available.
- Students applying for our elementary or middle school programs will be waitlisted while we collect their school records from the last year of their schooling, as well as any standardized test scores they may have received. Students applying to grades 1-8 will also need to have a teacher recommendation form filled out by a recent teacher who can give our school an idea of their strengths and any challenges.  - Once all records and recommendations and (if applicable) any special evaluations (504 plan, IEP, psychological evaluations, etc) have been received, your child will then be invited to shadow our school for two days. Afterwards, if our staff and teachers, you as parents, and your child all agree that SHMA is in fact the best place for them to continue their education, we will then support you in our school's enrollment process.
